Tour #6: New York Botanical Gardens – Situated on 100 ha (~ 250 acres) in the Bronx Borough of New York City, this National Historic Landmark includes an extensive array of gardens, a conservatory, and a world-class research and education center. The Bronx Botanical Gardens is an oasis of large, fully mature specimens of trees, shrubs, perennials and annuals, all wonderfully planted and displayed in an urban setting. At this stop, you will hear about the Garden's many research and conservation programs and will have plenty of time to walk through the extensive collection of the more than 50 individual gardens, trails and water features.
