Tour #4: **Central Park** (1st stop) - Located in the heart of Manhattan, New York City, this National Historic Landmark was designed by Frederick Law Olmstead who is considered by many to be the father of American landscape architecture. The park is maintained by the Central Park Conservancy, a private, not-for-profit organization which has invested millions of dollars for its restoration and management. On this tour, you will visit the recently renovated Great Lawn and Lake as well the Central Park Conservatory Garden, and will hear about the many conservation projects that seek to restore and maintain this iconic park.

Museum of Natural History (2nd stop) – The American Museum of Natural History is one of the world's preeminent scientific and cultural institutions. Established in 1869, the Museum is renowned for its exhibitions and scientific collections. Attendees will have time to explore the extensive collection of artifacts and exhibits after a picnic lunch in Central Park, and will return to the Hyatt just in time for the BBQ dinner at the Rutgers Turf Farm.
